Mid-quarter Progress Reports have been shared and PJP is hosting virtual Parent-Teacher-Student conferences on Wednesday, March 6th from 5:30 - 7:30 PM. These conferences are designed to provide an opportunity for parents and teachers to partner together to provide support to a student who is experiencing difficulty in any of their classes. These conferences are virtual appointments over zoom and students are welcome and encouraged to join in the conversation. If your child received a Failure Warning in any class, you are asked to please be sure you schedule a conference with the teacher. Please remember that these conferences are reserved for the parents of those students who are facing academic challenges. Please understand that grades are constantly changing and being updated as your student progresses through the curriculum. For the most up to date information, you are encouraged to monitor your student's progress through the tools available to you in the PowerSchool parent portal. Please remember that the Guidance Department and the Panthers' Learning Center are resources for all students who find that they may need some extra support.



This week we hosted Class Meetings for the classes of 2025, 2026, 2027 to present information about the upcoming Course Selection process. The students were encouraged to speak with their parents and guidance counselors about what their plans are both within and beyond PJP to help them make wise decisions about what courses to choose. We are working on finalizing the 2024-2025 Course Catalog and preparing to open the Course Selection Process in PowerSchool each of which are expected to be available by March 15.

Members of the Class of 2027 have the least choice as most of their elective selections will be filled by their graduation requirements in World Languages, Art, Technology, Health, or Physical Education. However, even these students benefit from having these conversations to be sure that they are set up for success when they are upperclassmen and have more selective opportunities.

#### **School Uniform Reminders**

Students are expected to remain in their full winter uniform until the beginning of the 4th quarter (April 8, 2024). Over the past two weeks we have reminded all of our students their responsibilities with respect to the winter uniform. We are asking all parents for support with reiterating these expectations at home. Please see the winter uniform requirements below. Thank you.

#### **Ladies' Winter Uniform**

An official PJPII plaid Flynn & O'Hara skort, NO SHORTER THAN ONE INCH ABOVE THE KNEE.

A white button-down blouse that is banded at the bottom (long or short sleeve).

Navy blue opaque Flynn and O'Hara tights without rips, tears, or holes. (NO leggings with socks are permitted).

The regulation school shoe – burgundy, Classic Eastland Penny Loafers, or brown, Eastland Plainview Oxfords.

#### **Gentlemen's Winter Uniform**

Official gray Flynn & O'Hara dress pants with belt (black).

A white button-down collar shirt (long or short sleeve).

Navy and gold striped tie. Seniors are permitted to wear an appropriate tie of their choice.

The regulation school shoe Nunn Bush - Bleeker Street (Black) Clean shaven.

Hair is to be clean and neat, may not fall below the shirt collar, and must not obstruct or cover their face or eyes.

#### **All Students**

White Undershirts only.

Navy blue school sweater, vest or blazer. **Special Note:** Seniors may wear the senior fleece in place of the sweater. They must also wear their winter uniform shirts under their fleeces.

Student ID on a PJP school lanyard worn on around their neck during the school day.


