## RENAISSANCE Star Assessments®

PJP uses Star Assessments in both Math and Reading to measure student progress during the course of the year. The first baseline assessments for 2023-2024 will take place during the week of October 2-6. All students will take the ELA assessment during HR on Wednesday, October 4th, and math assessment dates for all students will take place in their classrooms on the date their teacher selects. Students will also take assessments in the late winter and early spring, and an annual report will be shared with parents at the end of the academic year.

Results of the assessments are used by teachers in the classrooms to ensure that students are mastering standards and individual scores are reviewed by teachers and administrators during the course selection process in the spring. These assessments take most students about 25-30 minutes to complete and are taken on their chromebooks. Please be sure that your student remembers to charge their chromebook each night, and brings it to school each day.

## **Panthers' Learning Center**

The PJP leadership and staff are committed to helping our students succeed in the classroom and beyond. One of the ways we support our students academically is through the Academic Intervention Program. The Academic Intervention Team consists of our school leadership, the Guidance team, the Athletic Director, and the Director of Academic Support, and they review our students' grades weekly.

Students who are failing two or more classes for any reason (including missing work, assessment grades, or absences) when the weekly grade report is reviewed may be asked to attend two study halls that week, either at lunch or after school, in the Panthers' Learning Center. Students who do not attend when asked may receive demerits.

We hope that Academic Intervention continues to be a supportive resource for students, as it enabled us to significantly reduce quarterly course failures and nearly eliminate course failures for the year last year.

The Panthers' Learning Center is open from 2:30-4:00 PM for students to study after school, and students can request study time using this <u>form</u> at least one day in advance.
