Of all 15 secondary schools in the Archdiocese of Philadelphia, PJP is the only school whose enrollment is higher today than it was on the first day of school. Current PJP enrollment is 751 while enrollment on the first day of school was 742. This increase is a credit to the faculty, staff, administration, students and families who continue to care so much not only about Catholic education, but Catholic education at PJP.


The classes are 4 Chemistry and 1 Biology class. Recent college graduates are welcome to apply.

Academic Affairs



The opportunity to select courses for the upcoming academic year is now available for students in the PowerSchool portal. All required courses have been pre-selected for students based on the recommendations of their teachers. Members of the Class of 2027 who took Health and Physical Education this year should select from either the year-long art electives or select the semester-long Intro to Fine Arts and Intro to STEAM pairing to satisfy their graduation requirements in Fine Arts, Healthy, Physical Education and Technology. Students who are engaged in year-long art programs will have the opportunity to satisfy their other graduation requirements in later years.

All course requests MUST be submitted by Friday, April 19th. Students are encouraged to make appointments with their guidance counselor to discuss their course options and future plans.



All students enrolled in an AP course must take the AP Exam for the course, including those taken by dual enrollment with the Arrupe Virtual Learning Institute. Below is the exam schedule dictated by the CollegeBoard. Please note that even though school is closed on Thursday, May 9th to observe the Feast of the Ascension, both the AP Environmental Science and AP Psychology exams are scheduled for that day and all students in both of these classes will have to report to school for their exam.

Spring/Summer Uniform

Beginning Monday, April 8rd, the start of the 4th quarter, students may begin to wear the spring uniform.

- All students may choose to wear an official Pope John Paul II High School polo in place of the shirt, blouse, tie, and sweater. Any shirt placed under the polo must be white, tucked, and not protrude from the bottom of the polo or past the ends of the sleeves. If students are cold, they are permitted to wear a long sleeve polo, school sweater, or winter uniform. Sweatshirts or PJP sports attire are not permitted during the school day.
- Ladies have the option to wear navy blue opaque Flynn and O'Hara knee socks pulled to the knee in place of their tights.

The spring uniform is optional, students may continue to wear the full winter uniform if they wish, especially on cooler spring days.


Teacher Head and Beard Shaving Contest



College Academic Accommodations Workshop-Thursday, April 18th at 6:30 PM (Virtual)

Find out how students can apply for 504 and IEP accommodations in college. Dr. Andrea Swift, Director of Accessibility Services at Alvernia University, will provide information regarding what services are available and how to access those services.
