Due to the schedule changes last week, the Spring Concert has been rescheduled to this Tuesday, May 6th. Come out to enjoy some beautiful music!


The PJP Art Show is Wednesday, May 7th in the Atrium. If you have never attended an Art Show before, you need to see this!

Academic Affairs

Progress reports for the 4th quarter were sent electronically on Friday afternoon. These reports are a frozen snapshot of performance when the report was printed and grades are constantly being updated. You are encouraged to monitor your child's most current progress using the tools within the PowerSchool parent portal. With just 6 weeks left in the school year, if your child is struggling in any classes you are encouraged to reach out to the teacher directly.

Any student with a course failure at the end of the year will be required to remediate the course through our online summer school program before they will be able to return to PJP in September. Students who fail 3 or more classes for the year may be academically dismissed from PJP.



AP Exam testing will begin on Monday with Biology in the morning, and AVLI European History and AVLI Microeconomics in the afternoon. The schedule for the next two weeks is posted below. Students are excused from classes on the dates that they are taking exams, and may dress down in PJP spirit wear following the standard dress down day rules. Afternoon exams generally dismiss around 3:00 p.m. and students who ride the bus will need to find alternate transportation.

This year, exams are either fully or partially digital, and students must bring their fully charged chromebooks and chargers for testing. We do not have any loaner devices or cords.

Savor the Flavor Dress Down Day

Dress Down Day Rules:

Students may wear sweatpants or jeans. Clothing must be appropriate for school. IDs must be worn and visible. Students may not wear shorts or leggings/tights/yoga pants. Students may not wear clothing with inappropriate slogans/sayings. Students may not wear open toed/open heeled footwear. Students may not wear ripped/torn clothing or shirts without sleeves. Dress Down Theme must be the outermost layer of clothing.

Students who do not have or wish not to participate in the dress down theme may wear PJP Uniform in place of the designated dress. Remember that failure to pay attention to these directives will result in demerits being issued.

This information will aid counselors in writing the individualized counselor letter of recommendation.
