Underclass Exams: June 5, 6, 9

There will be 3 exam blocks each day, and each block is 65 minutes long. Dismissal will be at 11:30. If your student rides the bus to and from school, please review the <u>Early Dismissal Transportation Schedule 2024-2025</u> to confirm whether or not your child will need alternative transportation. Not all districts bus on early dismissal days, and some only provide transportation TO school.

Arrival is normal time at 7:50 with prayer and pledge taking place in the 1st exam room, there are no scheduled homerooms. Students ONLY need to report to school when they have an exam scheduled. Some teachers may have utilized alternative assessments such as a project or report, and in that case your student may not need to report to school. The last exam period is a designated CONFLICT period for any students who may have multiple exams scheduled in the same block, or who missed an exam day. Conflict exams are scheduled between the student and the teacher at a time that is convenient for both of them but may NOT BE scheduled prior to the posted exam schedule.

The cafeteria will be open as a quiet study space during all exam periods and after school for students who need to report early or stay late to wait for transportation.



One Book One School - Since 2021, PJP has participated in a One School, One Book program where each year a book selection is made that *all* members of the PJP community: students, faculty, and staff will read over the summer. For example, last year, our selection was Carlo Acutis: The First Millennial Saint. Medication Pick Up

If your PJP student has any medication stored in the nurse's office, please make arrangements with us at nurse@pjphs.org for pick-up prior to your student's last day. There is no nurse available for pick up once the school year ends, and storing meds for the summer is not permitted.

- EpiPens, Inhalers, and Diabetes Supplies can be taken home by students.
- Daily or 'as needed' medications must be picked up by a parent/guardian.

Rising Seniors

Dose 2 of MCV is required by PA Immunization Law for attendance in 12th grade. Students who have not completed this obligation will not receive a parking pass and will be excluded from school after day 5 of senior year. Medically signed waivers are accepted at PJP. Emails were sent on 5/21/25 to parents and students who do not currently have this dose on file.

Rising Juniors

A completed physical with updated vaccines (including dose 2 of MCV) is required in 11th grade. As your student gets the age 16 well-check OR a sports physical, please have a physical form (or copy of PIAA exam) completed and sent to nurse@pjphs.org.
