SILENT AUCTION AND RAFFLE BASKET INFORMATION

- Items available for bidding in the Silent Auction and Raffle Basket tickets are posted on the auction website at https://www.accelevents.com/e/savor-the-flavor-prom-night
- Each item will have its own item number and bid code. All Silent Auction bids and Raffle Ticket submissions should be made via text to the event phone number (**319**) **332-5708**.
- For assistance with Silent Auction bidding or Raffle Basket tickets, please visit the "PJP Tech Support" table in the lobby.
- The Silent Auction will close at 9:30 PM. After the Silent Auction closes, the bidder with the highest dollar amount will win the item. No time extensions will be provided.

LIVE AUCTION

- The Live Auction will begin at approximately 8:00 PM and will continue until all items are sold. Please remain seated until LIVE is completed. Check-Out will not open until all items are sold.
- To enter a bid, the bidder must raise his or her paddle high enough to attract the attention of the auctioneers or one of the spotters, who will relay your bid to the auctioneers. You will not use your Smart device to bid during the Live Auction.
- The auctioneer reserves the right to announce conditions of the sale at any time. In the event of a dispute, the auctioneer will have sole and final discretion in these matters.
- All sales are final upon the pronouncement of the winning bidder by the auctioneers. An auction volunteer will approach winning bidders immediately after they are announced winners to confirm method of payment.

LIVE AUCTION CHECK OUT

- Check-Out will open at the end of the Live Auction at approximately 9:00 PM and will remain open until the conclusion of the event. No one will be permitted in the Check-Out area before it opens, except the Check-Out staff.
- Payment must be rendered in Check-Out, the winners will receive a Paid Receipt of all items won/bought, and merchandise must be picked up on the night of the auction unless other arrangements are made with PJP staff.


