We are quickly approaching the end of the school year and there are some details that require your student's attention. They have received an email from me with the following details...

Please make sure that you submit your access cards to the Student Services Office for summer updating.

Student Services Office (anytime)

The card must be the same card that you were issued at the start of the school year. Those that do not have their access cards or those who do not turn in their access card by their final day of the 2023-2024 school year will be charged the \$30 replacement fee for a new card at the start of the 2024-2025 school year.

Cards will not be accepted at the beginning of the 2024-2025 school year.
