



Limerick Protective Response Plan

Pope John Paul II High School has developed plans to protect students should an incident at Limerick Generating Station require a protective response. Normally, schools will close before any protective actions are necessary; however, in the event that sheltering or evacuation is necessary, PJP has plans for accomplishing those protective actions. Communication with parents and guardians during emergencies will take place through the School Messenger telephone broadcast system. In the event of an emergency, please do not call the school or your child's cell phone so that we can maintain open communication with emergency officials. To make the plans effective, your cooperation is essential.

If an advisory to shelter is given, students will remain in the school building. Students will not dismiss until the shelter advisory is lifted. **PLEASE DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PICK UP YOUR CHILDREN** because it is important for everyone to remain inside during a shelter advisory. According to Montgomery County Department of Public Safety, no one may be admitted into the building to prevent contamination.

If evacuation is necessary and there is not sufficient time to send children home and complete the normal daily dismissal schedule, students will be transported to a "HOST" school. The host school for Pope John Paul II High School is Archbishop John Carroll High School located on 211 Matson Ford Road in Radnor, PA.

PLEASE DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PICK UP YOUR CHILDREN AT PJP. It is important that school driveways and access routes remain open for buses. In addition, when evacuation is required, the school is concerned that an evacuation be safe and orderly, that we maintain an accurate attendance throughout the operation, and that parents/guardians be reunited with their students as quickly and conveniently as possible. School staff will accompany students during the evacuation and will remain until all students are picked-up. Students will only be released to parents or the individuals included on the Authorization for Student Pick-up form. Your authorization will remain in effect only during the 2023-2024 school year.
