PARKING REGULATIONS

Any vehicle a student brings to school must be registered in the Student Services Office and must display the proper permit issued by the school, on the rear view mirror. Permits must be purchased every year through the Student Services Office at a cost of \$50.00. Payment will be charged to your students FACTS account.

- Student must park in the numbered space that is indicates on their permit.
- **Cars parked without a permit or parked in another student, faculty/staff, visitors, Athletic wing or Administrator’s spot will receive a \$25.00 fine and are subject to towing.**
- Students must obey all traffic laws on school property. Speed limit is 10 mph. Stop at all stop signs.
- Buses have the right of way. No one should merge into the line of exiting buses.
- No parking in the fire lanes or bus lanes.
- Parking lot and student vehicles are off limits during school hours.
- Students are not to sit or hang around cars in the lot, before, during, or after school. Doing so, will result in demerits for out of bounds.
- For the safety of all drivers and property, ball playing of any kind is NOT permitted before, during or after school.
- In the event of snow – no throwing snowballs or climbing snow piles.
- The school is NOT responsible for stolen articles, accidents, or damages that take place on school property.

Reckless driving, speeding, or violation of the above rules is subject to demerits and detention or suspension of driving privileges.
