Happy New Year from the Panthers' Learning Center! Have you thought about your New Year's resolution? As we continue through the second quarter and look toward semester exams, we encourage students to check their grades regularly, meet with their teachers, and use the resources offered by the Panthers' Learning Center like <u>after school studying</u> and <u>National Honor Society tutoring</u>. These are great ideas for academic resolutions!

The Panthers Achieving Worthwhile Success (PAWS) program provides individualized and intentional support to students with documented learning differences who may have benefited from academic support and accommodations in their previous schools.

Mr. Joseph Rogers, our Director of Academic Support, and our school leadership are hosting an information session to introduce both current and prospective families to the PAWS program on Thursday, January 11, 2024 at 6:00PM in the Panthers' Learning Center at PJP. College Admission Trends: Tuesday, January 23rd at 6:30 PM (Virtual)

Attention underclassman students and parents, take a deep dive into college admissions today with Dr. Kevin Bukatman, President of College Planning Service America, taking a look at the college admission process and the most important factors within a college application. FASFA: Opens December 31, 2023

If you are applying for financial aid for college, the Department of Education has announced the 2024-2025 FAFSA will be available by December 31, 2023.

But, first, you need to create your FSA ID ... don't wait to do this because it can take a number of days for the Department of Education to verify your information. Dependent students will need an FSA ID for one or both of their parents as well. All students and contributors (such as parents and spouses) must create an FSA Account—even if the contributor does not have a Social Security number. The FSA ID (account username and password) allows students and parents to identify themselves electronically to access, complete, sign, and submit a FAFSA form.

If you don't already have an FSA ID, go to: **<u>studentaid.gov/fsa-id/create-account/launch</u>** to create an FSA ID now.

Parents: If you previously created an FSA ID, you don't need to create another one. You can only have one FSA ID linked to your Social Security number. However, if you don't remember your username, select "Forgot Username." If you verified your email address or mobile phone number during account creation, you may enter your email address or mobile phone number instead of your username. If you forgot your password, select "Forgot Password," and follow prompts to reset your password.

SENIORS: College Acceptances and Scholarship & Grant Awards Please Submit to the Guidance Office

As seniors begin to receive college acceptances and scholarships & grant awards, please have your senior submit this good news to the Guidance Office! They can either make a copy of the acceptances or financial awards and drop it off to Mrs. Bell, Guidance Office Administrative Assistant, or they can take a screenshot / picture of it and email it to her at dbell@piphs.org.
