Dear Parents and Guardians,

I hope you and your family are having a great start to the school year.

Thank you for your ongoing trust, partnership, and support of Pope John Paul II High School. Together, we continue to make PJP a place where faith and excellence thrive.

I am writing to share an important update about how tuition and fees will be structured at Pope John Paul II High School. Beginning with the 2026–2027 school year, tuition and the school fee will be combined into a single, all-inclusive rate. When you receive the updated tuition schedule in February, you'll notice this new combined total.

Rest assured that everything currently covered by the school fee will continue to be included in this new structure.

Fees not previously included in the school fee such as: PAWS, Kairos, Graduation, Registration, AP Exams, Prom, Student Parking, ID cards, and Locks, will remain as individual charges and will continue to be billed separately.

Across our Archdiocesan schools, 12 of the 15 secondary schools have already adopted this tuition model. The Office of Catholic Education is encouraging all secondary schools to do the same to promote greater transparency, clarity, and consistency for families.

At PJP, our mission remains the same: to provide your child with a superior education and faith formation in a caring, Christ-centered community. Every day, our students bring vibrant energy to our campus, and we are truly grateful to have them as part of our community.

The tuition rate for the 2026–2027 school year, inclusive of the school fee, will be shared with families in early February, once our budget has been passed by the PJP Board and approved by the Office of Catholic Education.

WINTER UNIFORM

Students will begin wearing their winter uniform Monday, October 20, 2025. They will

remain in their full winter uniform until the beginning of the 4th quarter (March 30, 2026). We have begun reminding our students about their responsibilities with respect to the winter uniform. We are asking all parents for support by reiterating these expectations at home. Please see the winter uniform requirements below. Thank you in advance for your support.

Ladies' Winter Uniform:

- An official PJPII plaid Flynn & O'Hara skort, no shorter than one inch above the knee.
- A white button-down blouse that is banded at the bottom (long or short sleeve).
- Navy blue opaque Flynn and O'Hara tights without rips, tears, or holes. (NO leggings or socks are permitted).
- The regulation school shoe burgundy, Classic Eastland Penny Loafers, or brown, Eastland Plainview Oxfords.

Gentlemen's Winter Uniform:

- Official gray Flynn & O'Hara dress pants with belt (black).
- Black belt.
- A white button-down collar shirt (long or short sleeve).
- Navy and gold striped tie. Seniors are permitted to wear an appropriate tie of their choice.
- The regulation school shoe Nunn Bush Bleeker Street (Black)
- Clean shaven.
- Hair is to be clean and neat, may not fall below the shirt collar, and must not obstruct or cover their face or eyes.

All students:

- White undershirts only.
- Navy blue school sweater, vest or blazer. Special Note: Seniors may wear the senior fleece in place of the sweater. They must also wear their winter uniform shirts under their fleeces.
- Student ID on a PJP school lanyard worn on around their neck during the school day.

COLLEGE FINANCIAL AID FORMS – FAFSA and CSS Profile

FAFSA - Open Now

The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is the application used to apply for federal student aid, such as federal grants, work-study, and loans. In addition, many states and colleges use your FAFSA information to determine your eligibility for state and school aid, and some private financial aid providers may use your FAFSA information to determine whether you qualify for their aid.

The FAFSA is now fully available for families to fill out. So, create your *StudentAid.gov* account so you can complete the FAFSA. Please note, while the federal FAFSA deadline isn't until June, many colleges and states have much earlier priority deadlines - some as early as November - January. Submitting the FAFSA by your student's earliest deadline is the best way to maximize eligibility for financial aid.

CSS Profile – Open Now

In addition to the FAFSA, there are about 300 colleges and universities that require the

completion of an additional financial aid form called the CSS Profile. The CSS Profile is used for consideration of any institutional aid that the college may be able to offer your student. Again, like the FAFSA, the CSS Profile has a variety of deadlines to consider. Your exact deadline depends on the specific college you're applying to, so check the colleges' websites.

Post Season Update


