Panthers' Learning Center

Our goal in the Panthers' Learning Center is to position all students for academic success which is why we, along with guidance counselors and school leadership, check the grades of all students on a weekly basis as part of Academic Intervention.

Academic Intervention officially begins this Wednesday.

- Students who are failing two or more classes when the grade report is pulled on Tuesdays during 8th period will be asked to come to the Learning Center twice that week at lunch or before/after school to work on assignments and study for upcoming tests.
- Additionally, students failing one class and their families may periodically receive an email notifying them of this and encouraging them to check their grades.
- We understand that the grade report at any given time is simply a snapshot of grades and may not accurately reflect student performance (due to absences, extensions, or assignments waiting to be graded). Because grades are constantly changing, sometimes grades are updated right after our notification emails are sent!

It is important for us, however, to ensure that students and families are aware of grades to avoid any potential interruptions to activities and participation in summer school. Our Academic Intervention Initiative has helped nearly eradicate course failures here at PJP, and we are proud of our students' hard work.

Did You Miss Us at Back to School Night?

The EITC program is a unique opportunity for Pennsylvania taxpayers and businesses with a state tax liability of \$1,000 or more to support scholarships for students at Pope John Paul II High School. Simply check Line 12 of your PA state tax return to see if you qualify. By participating, you can redirect your state tax dollars to provide much-needed tuition assistance for our families. In fact, over 25% of our students rely on these scholarships to attend PJP. Even better—you'll receive a 90% tax credit toward your total state tax liability.

The homecoming dance is Saturday Oct. 4 at 7pm until 9:30p. Students must be here and in before 7:30. Parents need to sign the Conduct Form for dances in order for their child to attend.

The Homecoming Dance is a semi-formal event. In general, students are expected to be clean and neat in their personal appearance, observing standards of modesty, moderation, and good taste. Any interpretation, judgment and final authority in these matters lies with the Administration. No transparent material is permitted. Clothing displaying any offensive or sexually-suggestive language, or anything related to tobacco products, alcohol, or other illegal drugs will not be permitted. Clothing should be clean, hemmed, and not ripped. Students not in compliance with the Dress Code may be asked to leave.

Dress length and neckline should be appropriate, and no bare midriffs or sides are permitted. Two-piece dresses must overlap at the waist. Backless dresses are unacceptable and any opening in the back must be no lower than the waist. Strapless and spaghetti-strap tops are allowed insofar as they do not reveal cleavage and are appropriate length.

Appropriate gentlemen's attire includes a dress shirt and tie, a suit, or sport coat with dress slacks and dress shoes.
